The upcoming spell of hot, dry weather will result in a high to extreme fire danger rating throughout most of the Kamloops Fire Centre area once again.

The Kamloops Fire Centre has experienced recent wildfires resulting from industrial high risk activities being conducted on cutting permit areas. Due to the cooperation and effort of industry workers and fire suppression crews, these fires were detected early and extinguished in the initial attack phase.


These fires serve as a reminder to ensure that companies and contractors, when conducting operations, remain very cautious and diligent.

Please pay particular attention to the fire danger rating in your area and ensure you are using the appropriate weather station data for the area in which you are operating and adhere to the shutdown formulas in the Wildfire Regulation.

Remember, if you see or cause a wildfire, you have an obligation to report it, take action with available resources and extinguish it, if practicable. Do your part to help prevent unwanted wildfires.
